What are the qualifications about?

An Award in Preparing to Teach in the Lifelong Learning Sector provides an introduction to teaching and training adults. It is an essential first step towards practitioner status - a licence to teach in the Lifelong Learning Sector (England), as well as being relevant to other nations.

Who are they for?

This Award is for new entrants to the lifelong learning sector who don't have prior teaching experience or qualifications. It also suits people already working in the area who want to gain official qualifications. You should have an idea of what subject you'd like to teach and either have, or be working towards, a qualification in that area.

This comprises one mandatory and a range of optional units, including:

- Roles, responsibilities and relationships in lifelong learning
- Understanding inclusive learning and teaching in lifelong learning
- Using inclusive learning and teaching approaches in lifelong learning
- Facilitate learning and development in groups
- Facilitate learning and development for individuals
- Principles of assessment in lifelong learning.

Course Duration

3 - 6 months. This course duration is dependent on the learner.
